

WEBSITE PRIVACY POLICY

This policy is provided pursuant to article of the Regulation (UE) 2016/679 (the “**Regolamento**” o “**GDPR**”) to those who browse the following website:

www.studioteruzzi.com (the “**Sito Web**”)

The policy describes the personal data processing made through the Web Site. It should also be noted that this policy concerns exclusively the Web Site, with the exclusion of any Internet site which the visitor may be redirected through links that might be available within the Web Site.

1. WHO IS THE DATA CONTROLLER?

Gesis S.r.l., registered office in Agrate Brianza (MB), Centro Direzionale Colleoni, Palazzo Astrolabio, P.IVA 00977960962, in the person of its *pro tempore* legal representative, is the Controller of your personal data (“**Gesis**” or the “**Controller**”).

2. WHAT IS PERSONAL DATA?

“Personal Data” means any recorded information that is about you, who is browsing the Web Site, and from which you can be identified (“Data”).

Specifically, the Controller processes or may process data such as the IP address, domain name, and URL of the device being used.

3. WHAT ARE THE PURPOSES OF YOUR DATA PROCESSING AND ITS LEGAL BASIS?

The Data Controller collects and processes your Data in order to carry out activities concerning the management and administration of the Website, in order to improve the visitor’s browsing experience, pursuant to art. 6, par. 1, let. f), GDPR.

In any case, we are committed to ensure the information collected and used are appropriate with respect to purposes of the Controller and that will not result in an invasion of your personal sphere.

4. COOKIES

Cookies are files with a small amount of data information sent by a web server (e.g., the site) to the user’s internet browser, automatically stored on the user’s device and automatically sent back to the web server each time the site is accessed.

By default, almost all web browsers are set to automatically accept cookies. Visitors can set their device's browsers to accept/reject all cookies or display a warning whenever a cookie is offered, so they can consider whether to accept it. Users can, however, change the default configuration and disable cookies (i.e., block them outright) by setting the highest level of protection.

The Controller uses only technical cookies – whose installation does not require your consent – in order to ensure the proper functionality of the website and provide users with the requested services.

The cookies used are session cookies that are automatically deleted from your device when you finish browsing the web site.

5. WHERE IS YOUR DATA TRANSFERRED TO?

The server where the Web Site is located is in Italy.

Your Data may be transferred to entities that Gesis uses to carry out activities necessary to achieve the purposes indicated and described in paragraph 3 above including external companies that offer Gesis maintenance and development services of the Website and, in general, services, specifically appointed as data controllers under Article 28, GDPR. In addition, where such communication is possible or required by law, your data may be communicated to other companies, competent Authorities or Public Bodies, which process them for their own purposes as autonomous data controllers.

The list of data processors can be requested by contacting the Data Controller at the contact details indicated in paragraph 7 below.

In any case, your Data will not be transferred outside the European Economic Area or disseminated.

6. HOW LONG IS YOUR DATA KEPT?

We process your Data as long as is strictly necessary to achieve the purposes stated in paragraph 3 above.

The data are anonymized immediately. However, in case of detection of computer crimes, the Data will be processed for the time necessary to this purpose.

We reserve the right to retain so-called log data for longer periods in order to be able to handle any crimes committed against the Website (e.g., hacking).

7. WHAT ARE YOUR RIGHTS AS DATA SUBJECT?

You, as data subject, have the right to:

- Access and request copies of Data;
- Request rectification or updating of data, where inaccurate or incomplete;

- Request, under certain circumstances, the deletion of the data or the restriction of processing involving Data;
- Request the portability of the Data;
- Object to the processing of Data (where applicable);
- Withdraw consent, where the processing of Data was based on the aforementioned condition of lawfulness.

Finally, you may at any time file a complaint with the Data protection Authority.
